## 2027 U.S. Open Volunteer Committee Descriptions

**WAITLIST ONLY Standard Bearers** \*(Ages 14 through 17 ONLY)\*: Carry a two-sided scoring sign (standard), weighing approximately 10 lbs., with groups during championship week, including the practice rounds to assist fans in identifying players. Will be required to walk 18 holes. During competition rounds, scores are kept on the standard and are updated as needed after every hole. This committee has a very limited number of positions available and is expected to fill quickly based on a first-come, first-served basis. The ability to navigate 18 holes and follow players on foot is required.
